Overview

- **Our guidelines for uniforms and appearance are intended to encourage modesty and simplicity in appearance, thus minimizing distractions and fostering an environment conducive to learning and growing in virtue. Thank you for your attention to these guidelines!**

- Students may not wear or bring any items with identifiable or themed characters. This includes backpacks, lunch boxes, water bottles, outerwear, etc.
- Logo insignias are acceptable.

Students Uniform

- Please be sure to LABEL EVERYTHING (including gloves and hats!).

- **K-12th Students**
 - [Lands End Embroidered Polo](#)
 - The link will take you to a video showing you how to order these and what we recommend.
 - Girls
 - Lands End “Below the Knee” length skirt.
 - Log in to our school code on Lands End to be sure you’re getting the right one.
 - Skirts must be below the knee. Leggings or long shorts do not make up for this.
 - Solid navy blue leggings or solid navy blue knee-length undershorts should be worn under their skirt at all times.
 - Boys
 - Jeans, khakis, or khaki shorts
 - Shoes or boots neutral in color
 - Mud Boots
 - Must be left AT THE FARM
 - Rain jacket
 - Cold Weather gear
 - Coats, jackets, hats, gloves...
 - 7th-12th grade students should wear a watch daily.
 - No devices including Apple watches will be allowed on campus and if brought, are collected daily for return at the end of the day.
- **PreK 4**
 - Plain navy blue polo
 - Does not have to be St. Isidore polo
 - Girls
 - Khaki knee-length skirt or St Isidore skirt
 - Or skort
 - Navy blue leggings and undershorts
 - Boys
 - Jeans, khakis, or khaki shorts
 - Shoes or boots
 - Mud boots

- **Nursery & Playground**
 - There is no specific dress code for these kids, however:
 - Children should be dressed for the weather to allow On Campus Adults to take them outside to stroll and/or play
 - Please send spare clothes daily and keep a setup of backup clothes indoors.
 - [Walking Children](#) should have mud boots kept at the farm and [Full body Rain Suit](#) for outdoor play during wet days

On Campus Adults Uniform

- Lands End Embroidered Polo
 - With jeans, pants, or a skirt
 - Dark colored blue, black, or brown
 - No print or pattern
 - Below the knee
- OR a dress
 - Dark colored blue, black, or brown
 - No print or pattern
 - Below the knee
 - Abiding by the Modesty Guidelines for sleeves, backs, and necklines
- For Nursing Moms
 - Must be covered while nursing
 - You may nurse in the Nursery if you are more comfortable being uncovered.
- Mud boots
- Rain Jacket
- A watch - we discourage the use of cell phones as timekeepers

Accessories

- Please be sure to LABEL EVERYTHING. (We recommend [these labels](#).)
- Backpack with large 4"+ carabiner attached
- Lunch box
- Water bottle with a sealed lid
- **Nursery - 12th Grade:** Change of clothes (as close to uniform as possible) - kept in backpack/vehicle/classroom at all times for easy access
- Absolutely NO outside toys, books, or devices
 - Your child may not bring non-booklist books, toys and/or action figures, devices, etc. from home to campus at any time.
